

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MEETING

April 21, 2025 – 5:30PM

Second Floor, City Building, 201 S. Union Street

Mayor Kamron Yates opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. Those present rose for the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was livestreamed on YouTube.

Clerk-Treasurer Julie Price did roll call. Those present were Mayor Yates, Breanna Maxwell, and Spencer Kingery.

The minutes of April 7, 2025 meeting were presented for review. There was 1 correction per the clerk/treasurer for the attest signature line on the second page. Clerk/treasurer Price stated that it was not changed from the last meeting. Motion to approve minutes as corrected by Breanna Maxwell seconded by Spencer Kingery. Minutes were approved as corrected and carried. (3-0)

The next order of business was regular claims for April 21, 2025 totaling \$567,936.96. Motion to accept the claims made by Spencer Kingery, seconded by Breanna Maxwell. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)

New Business:

Dave Buck with BF&S opened and read the bids turned in for the CCMG 2025-1 project. Before reading bids he gave a project description. The bids were read as follows:

Reith-Riley \$1,379,943.40

Midwest Paving \$1,600,769.69

Milestone \$\$1,742,484.00

Only 1 bid was turned in for the Pavement preservation by Paving Solutions, Inc. for a total of \$321,004.85. Dave Buck made a request to the council to take each bid under advisement and review each bid to make sure all the totals and information presented was correct. The board agreed to the request. No vote was necessary.

Dave Buck presented the IPC water tower task order to the board. He stated that it BF&S would do the analysis per IDEM. It is functioning but will need updates with an assessment to determine the cost of the project. He was requesting authorization from the board for the inspection and project authorization. Motion to approve the authorization with modification to the presentation that the 2 items presented would be the 2 covered by the task order made by Spencer Kingery, seconded by Breanna Maxwell. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)

Nipsco excavation permit request was presented for approval for 407 S. Heritage Dr. Motion to approve the permit made by Breanna Maxwell, seconded by Spencer Kingery. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)

Future Business and Announcements:

Mayor Yates stated that he and Mayor Sims of Monticello read 2 joint proclamations. April was proclaimed Sexual Abuse and Child Abuse awareness month and that May would have a proclamation for Mental Health Awareness to be presented by both Mayors representing Carroll and White counties.

Mayor Yates thanked everyone that attended the State of the City, County, and Towns. It was a successful event with many upgrades and improvements happening in our communities.

The Easter Egg Hunt was once again successful and attended by several in the community.


