Excavation Permit request for 208 N. Robinson St. was presented for approval. Motion to approve the permit made by Spencer Kingery, seconded by Kamron Yates. Motion carried and passed. (2-0)

Tim Shriner of 101 S. Union St. presented a request for a 20 yd roll off dumpster to be located on the corner of Union and Franklin to take up 3 car lengths from May 21-28<sup>th</sup>. Motion to approve the dumpster placement made by Spencer Kingery, seconded by Kamron Yates. Motion carried and passed. (2-0)

Dave Buck with BF&S was present to finalize the CCMG documents awarded to Reith-Riley from last meeting and receive approval for the notice to proceed agreement to accept bid form. The forms would need Mayor signature and accept the bonds. The same procedure would need to be done for the pavement improvement project from Pavement Solutions. Motion to approve to finalize the documents made by Spencer Kingery, seconded by Kamron Yates. Motion carried and passed. (2-0)


