

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MEETING

Mayor Kamron Yates opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. Those present rose for the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was livestreamed on YouTube.

Clerk-Treasurer Julie Price called the roll. Present were Mayor Yates, Spencer Kingery, and new board member Paige Smith.

The minutes of the December 30, 2025 meeting were presented for review. There were no additions or corrections. Motion to approve minutes as read by Spencer Kingery, seconded by Mayor Yates. Paige Smith abstained from voting due to being newly appointed. Minutes were approved as read and carried (2-0) with 1 abstain.

The next order of business was regular claims for January 5, 2026 totaling \$73,734.46. Motion to accept the claims made by Spencer Kingery, seconded by Paige Smith. No discussion or changes. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)

Delphi Main Street 2026 contract renewal was presented to the board for review with no voting action items. The contract was presented to the board of works and will be voted on for approval by the city council.

Kendra Henderson of the Delphi Youth Baseball League was present to request permission for the Delphi Youth Baseball parade to take place on Saturday, April 25, 2026 at 10:00am with the same route as previous years. Motion to approve parade date, time, and route made by Paige Smith, seconded by Spencer Kingery. Motion carried and passed. (3-0)
