

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY MEETING

March 2, 2026 – 5:30PM

Mayor Kamron Yates opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. Those present rose for the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was livestreamed on YouTube.

Clerk-Treasurer Julie Price called the roll. Present were Mayor Yates, Paige Smith, and Spencer Kingery.

The minutes of February 17, 2026 meeting were presented for review. There were no additions or corrections. Motion to approve minutes as read by Paige Smith seconded by Spencer Kingery. Minutes were approved as read and carried. (3-0)

Mayor Yates informed the board of works of Resolution 2026-01 that would be presented to council for approval regarding the sale of surplus vehicles which will include the street department bucket truck. The bucket truck has been replaced with a newer used model for use by the street department.

Julia stated that would not be a problem to do so if possible.
